

Arena Regs and Rules 2006 Update

Silver Creek Equestrian Club strives diligently to provide the safest environment possible for members and guests to enjoy the facility as a whole. As our growth rate continues and activities increase, it is necessary at intervals to review and revise the Rules of Conduct and Procedures at the arena. While every situation can't be foreseen, the general rules do address all of the safety issues that we can prepare members for through our due diligence. This update is a continuation of the original rules, amended where needed and additional rules have been added in an effort to be as complete as possible. We ask all members to review the rule structure at this time to refresh your knowledge and to make sure you are aware of any changes or additions.

Rules of Conduct and Procedures

1. All members must have pertinent contact information on file in the office. Forms are available in the office.
2. Members with horses, boarded or visiting, must have a current Coggins for each horse on file in the office.
3. The speed limit for any motorized vehicle must be below 5 mph around the arena property.
4. ***Anyone under 18 must be supervised by a designated adult on the premises, adult defined as someone 18 years of older.***
5. Horses are to be kept OFF the concrete alleys, except when being led in and out of stalls.
6. Wash racks are to be kept clean and are for members only.
7. No horses are to be ridden, led or tied in the concession/picnic/playground areas.
8. Horses tied to the arena rail should be tied correctly and must not be known to kick.
9. Riders should mount and dismount inside the arena or outside the pedestrian/seating areas.
10. Pedestrians have the 'right of way' anywhere except in the arena.
11. No one should be in the arena on foot when horses are being worked. (exception: Instructors)
12. No one should use others' equipment without permission.
13. Non-boarding horses are not allowed in stalls or lots without permission.
14. No one should 'pet' or approach any horse without permission from the owner.
15. No one should feed any horse anything without permission from the owner.
16. Gates and doors should be left 'as found', unless it is obviously an issue.
17. All gates to the arena are to be closed at all times.
18. Timed events or running events must be done with the outside gate closed.
19. ***The arena is to be shared by all participants, taking turns if necessary.***
20. Jumping equipment can not be used without Instructor supervision or permission.
21. All trash should be disposed of properly and promptly.
22. All persons are expected to exhibit acceptable behavior at all times, Silver Creek is family oriented.
23. Guests are always welcome, however it is your responsibility to supervise your guests and relay the rules to them.
24. ***Small children, at least age 8 and under, should be under constant supervision at all times.***
25. ***All members under the age of 18 are required to wear riding helmets, unless signed helmet hold harmless placed on file in office.***
25. ***Infractions will be dealt with using an Investigation/Warning/Suspension/Expulsion system.***
